It is a role that will involve working in both the Clinical Trials and Research Department.

The Role

In this role, you will assist with organising, initiating and carrying out multiple funded data collection and research projects in one or more of the following areas, amongst others: Early, Intermediate, Late (Dry and Wet) Age-Related Macular Degeneration including Gene Therapy as a treatment option, amongst others; Wide-Field OCT and Imaging of the Peripheral Vitreoretinal Interface; Diabetic Macular Oedema; Inherited Retinal Dystrophies; Visual Aids; Vitreous Floaters and Opacities.

This position has a wide range of responsibilities including collecting data from diagnostic imaging equipment, assisting in setting up new projects, attending annual scientific ophthalmic meetings and produce study reports and scientific publications.
